

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL D-GROUP MEETING LOOK LIKE?

Every D-Group will look a bit different because of the varying personalities involved. However, it's a good idea to follow something similar to this.

TIME TO CATCH UP

1

Spend as much time as needed here. Remember, the most important aspect of D-Groups is doing life together, so don't feel like you need to rush this time of relationship-building.

2

PRAYER TIME

Spend some time sharing and praying over personal prayer concerns. It's a good idea to limit prayer requests to immediate family or close friends so the prayer time doesn't get too far off-track.

SCRIPTURE MEMORY/ACCOUNTABILITY

3

This is a time when you hold one another accountable for the memory verse and any other area of accountability the group has agreed upon.

4

BIBLE JOURNAL DISCUSSION

This is when you share together what God is teaching you through His Word. Make sure to focus on how each of you is living out what God is saying through His Word. The Big 3 Qs are essential here - What is God teaching you? What are you going to do about it? Who are you going to tell?

GOSPEL, MISSIONS, & MULTIPLICATION

5

Spend some time discussing who you are praying for to come to Christ and any Gospel conversations the group has had. This time is huge in making sure the group remains focused on making more disciples. This is also a good time to talk about a shared mission project together. After a few months, use this time to begin talking about what multiplying the group looks like.

6

CORE DISCUSSION

This is a time the D-Group Leader always leads.
This is a time to teach the core concepts.

PRAY

7

Close out the time in prayer.
