

PRAYING FOR YOUR D-GROUP

Praying is an integral part of leading those in your D-Group. God wants them to grow and mature even more than you do! Use this guide to regularly prompt your prayer time for those in your D-Group.

Pray that they would:

1. Commit all their lives to Jesus & obey His command to be filled with His Spirit (Philippians 2:9-11, Proverbs 3:5-6, Ephesians 5:18, Ephesians 1:23, Ephesians 4:13).
2. Truly know the depths & power of the love of God (Ephesians 3:14-19).
3. Learn to pray & praise God (Mark 10:14-15, Matthew 21:16).
4. Know who they are in Christ (Ephesians 1:4-11).
5. Be protected from the evil one through the blood of Jesus (John 17:15).
6. Receive and trust the Father's love (1 John 3:1).
7. Love the Word of God (Psalm 119:127, Psalm 119:159-162).
8. Learn to hate sin & love holiness, righteousness (Psalm 119:9-11, 2 Timothy 2:22, romans 16:19b, Romans 12:1, Proverbs 8:13).
9. Grow up into spiritual maturity (Ephesians 4:15, Colossians 2:6-7).
10. Glorify God in their bodies as His temple (1 Corinthians 6:19-20).
11. Respect those in authority over them (Romans 13:1, Ephesians 6:1).
12. Have healthy, edifying, wise friendships (Psalm 119:63).
13. Know the truth & renew their minds in God's truth (John 8:32, Romans 12:2).
14. Walk wisely in the ways & wisdom of God (Proverbs 3:5-6, Ephesians 5:8-10, 15-17).
15. Possess the joy of the Lord (Philippians 4:4).
16. Pursue God first and foremost (Matthew 6:33).
17. Seek to share the love of God with others in Gospel Conversations (1 Peter 3:15, 2 Corinthians 5:20, Matthew 28:19-20).
18. Seek to please God, not themselves or others (Matthew 4:10b, Psalm 19:14, Mark 10:43-45).
19. Develop the heart of a servant (Philippians 2:1-11).
20. Pour their lives into others and make disciples (2 Timothy 2:2, Matthew 28:19-20).
